Heather Allen Hietala's work has been shown in numerous venues, including the Wustum Museum of Fine Art (WI), the Mint Museum of Craft and Design (NC), the Atlanta International Museum of Art (GA), the American Museum of Quilts and Textiles (CA), the American Institute of Architects (DC), the Wesserling Textile Museum (France), and the Singapore Art Museum. Her work is held in diverse collections, including those of the Racine Art Museum (WI), the North Carolina Arts Commission, Fidelity Investments (MA), and the Biltmore Estate (NC). Her interest in other cultures has led her to teach and lecture in the United States, Canada, Japan, Singapore, Thailand and Nepal. Hietala holds an MFA from the University of Massachusetts (1993) and a BFA from the University of New Hampshire (1989).
