Mariel Waddell is an award-winning glass artist. She graduated from Hot Glass Forming at Sheridan College School of Craft and Design in April 2006. In 2005 she received the Betty Kantor Award and the Summer Residency Scholarship from the Harbourfront Center. In 2006 she received the Don Lee Award and an Honorable Mention for the 2006 Graduate Show.

Mariel was born in Trinidad and has lived in other tropical countries such as Barbados and Costa Rica. The experience of living in these countries has become the foundation of her inspiration. Using hot glass bits Mariel sculpts and captures pieces of the oceans reefs onto her vessels.

Currently Mariel is the owner of Kingston Glass Studio & Gallery in Kingston, Ontario. Mariel has also shown her sculptural glass designs in galleries across Canada and is part of the permanent collection of the Montreal Museum of Fine Art.
